**WARWICKSHIRE UNION TEAM CHALLENGE SHIELD
SCRATCH STROKE COMPETITION - 36 HOLES**

Clubs can enter ONE team of THREE players, handicap limit 4 (as defined in the accompanying notes). Players with higher handicaps are NOT eligible to compete. The scores of all three players will be aggregated and the Club whose team returns the lowest aggregate will hold the Challenge Shield for one year. Entry fee £22 per team. In addition, the winning Club will qualify and be expected to compete in the English Golf Union Champion Club Tournament to be held at Brancepeth Castle Golf Club on 26th and 27th August 2005.

WARWICKSHIRE AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP

36 holes scratch - handicap limit 4 - run concurrently with the above. The winner of the Amateur Championship will hold the replacement of the Carl Bretherton Vase for one year and receive a prize. A silver and bronze medal will be awarded to the 2nd and 3rd scratch scores for the 36 holes. Entry fee £20 per competitor. The winner will be expected to compete in the English County Champions Tournament at Woodhall Spa on 17th September 2005.

To be played concurrently with the above competition off handicap (limit 4) under handicap scheme of the Council of National Golf Unions. Entrance fee included in above.

**WARWICKSHIRE AMATEUR MATCH PLAY CHAMPIONSHIP
FOR THE T.P. COOKE CHALLENGE CUP**

The best 8 scratch scores in the above (subject to availability) qualify for a Match Play Championship over the Robin Hood Course. Ties for the 8th place will be decided on the score of the LAST 18 HOLES (and then the last 9, last 6, etc. of that 18 holes). The first round and the semi-finals of the competition will be played on Friday 8th July 2005 over 18 holes, and the final over 36 holes on Sunday 10th July 2005.
