IMPORTANT CONDITIONS

1. All competitions are open to all eligible members of the Clubs affiliated to the Union, and subject to Clause 3 below. No player shall be eligible to compete who has competed at any Meeting or Match of any other County or County Union since 25th May 2004.
2. Entries for the above competitors must be made through your Club Secretary and must reach the Secretary of the Warwickshire Union of Golf Clubs by **THURSDAY 12TH MAY 2005. PLAYERS WITH HANDICAPS OVER 4 ON THAT DATE ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE. COMPETITORS WILL PLAY OFF THEIR CURRENT HANDICAP (IF LOWER) ON THE DAY.**
3. The Union Executive **MAY** allow exceptions to the handicap rule in the case of players who have played for the 1st or 2nd team in 2003, 2004 or 2005, but all competitors will be advised of such players.
4. Any question which may arise as to qualifying, handicaps or any other matter, will be considered by the Executive Committee whose decision will be final. **THE COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO DECLINE ENTRIES WITHOUT REASON AND TO RESTRICT THE NUMBER OF ENTRIES IF THIS IS DEEMED DESIRABLE. REDUCTION WILL BE DEALT WITH BY BALLOTING OUT HIGHER HANDICAP PLAYERS.**
5. In the event of a tie, there will be a three-hole play-off over the 16th, 17th and 18th holes. If the scores are still level thereafter there will be a sudden death play-off over these same three holes.
6. The competition will be played under the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club, as supplemented by the Local Rules of Robin Hood Golf Club.
7. The competition will be played with the large (1.68") ball, of a make appearing on the R and A Approved List, a copy of which will be available on the day.
8. Clubs may not enter more than one team of 3 players (all 3 scores to count). Clubs may change their representative for the team event up to the day of the competition. Players taking part in the team event must also have entered for the individual competition.
9. Players are requested to make their own arrangements for caddies.
10. **PRACTICE:** Limited practice facilities may be available and to enquire about these players should contact the Club Professional Alan Harvey on 0121 706 0806, or the Club Secretary on 0121 706 0061.
11. **DRESS & ETIQUETTE:** Will competitors and any supporters please remember that they are guests of Robin Hood Golf Club and **THEY MUST BRING WITH THEM A COLLAR, TIE AND JACKET AND OBEY THE ETIQUETTE EXPECTED OF GUESTS AT ALL TIMES.**
12. **REFRESHMENTS:** A light lunch (soup and sandwiches) is included in the entrance fee. Evening meals can be arranged on the day for which competitors will be responsible for payment to the Club.
