

## WARWICKSHIRE MENS COUNTY TRIAL 2010

The Warwickshire Mens County Trial will be played on Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> April 2010  
At Sutton Coldfield Golf Club, 110 Thornhill Road, Streetly, Warwickshire B74 3ER

**Closing Date for Entry Applications is Friday 26<sup>th</sup> March 2010**

### **2010 CONDITIONS OF ENTRY AND PLAY**

1. Entry Qualifications:

To be eligible to enter, a player must :

- (a) be in possession of an ACTIVE CONGU playing handicap not exceeding 3 at the date of entry.  
(Note : exception may be made for players who have represented County 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> Teams in 2009)
- (b) enter this competition on the basis of their CONGU handicap
- (c) be a playing Member of a Warwickshire Golf Club affiliated to the County Golf Union.
- (d) obtain the permission of the County Secretary if he has represented another County, or played in another County's Championships during the preceding 12 months.

2. Conditions of Play:

- (a) The Trial shall be played as an 18 hole Gross Stableford.
- (b) The Winner will be the competitor who returns the highest Gross points over 18 holes. In the event of ties the Winner and lower placings will be decided on a count back basis taking into account the highest Gross points for the last 9, 6, 3, 2 and 1 holes. If this does not produce a result the scores on earlier holes will be taken into account on a similar basis until a result is obtained.
- (c) The use of ride-on buggies is generally prohibited in Warwickshire Union of Golf Club events. Players should walk at all times unless permission to ride has been given by the Championship Committee. Permission will only be given in exceptional circumstances.
- (d) The use of Distance Measuring Devices which conform with the current Rules of Golf is allowed.
- (e) Players driver heads and golf balls must conform with the current Rules of Golf.
- (f) Mobile telephones are not permitted to be used on the course, except in case of emergencies.
- (g) Caddies will be allowed.

3. Prizes:

- (a) Vouchers will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> Best Gross points scored.
- (b) Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Championships Committee.
- (c) Prize Winners and all other competitors are expected to be present at the prizegiving.

4. Entry Applications:

- (a) Entry Applications will only be accepted on the official WUGC Entry Form available on the County website or from your Club Secretary/Manager.
- (b) Entry Applications and related Fees must be received by the WUGC County Secretary NOT LATER THAN the specified closing date for entries.
- (c) No Entry Fees will be refunded unless intimation of scratching is received PRIOR TO the Draw Sheet being issued.
- (d) It is a strict condition of entry that where a competitor will be under the age of 18 years on the date of the competition, a Parental Consent Form is completed and returned to the WUGC County Secretary NOT LATER THAN the specified closing date for entries.

5. After play all competitors are required to change from their on course attire into appropriate attire as specified on the Draw Sheet.

6. The Competition will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club, and as supplemented by Local Rules.

7. Any questions arising as to Entry Qualifications, Rules of Golf, Resolution of Exceptional Ties or any other points will be considered by the Championship Committee whose decision will be final. The Committee reserve the right to limit the number of entries.
