

## WARWICKSHIRE SENIORS CHAMPIONSHIP 2008

The 30<sup>th</sup> Warwickshire Seniors Championship will be played on Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2008  
at Copt Heath Golf Club, 1220 Warwick Road, Knowle, Solihull, Warwickshire B93 9LN

### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

#### 1. Qualifications:

To be eligible to enter, a player must :-

- (a) have reached the age of 55 years before the day of the competition.
- (b) be in possession of a CONGU playing handicap at the date of entry as follows:

Aged 55 to 59:	Maximum 12 handicap
Aged 60 to 64 :	Maximum 13 handicap
Aged 65 to 69 :	Maximum 14 handicap
Aged 70 and over :	Maximum 16 handicap

- (c) be a member of a Warwickshire Golf Club affiliated to the County Golf Union.
- (d) enter this competition using his CONGU handicap.

#### 2. Conditions of Play:

- (a) The Championship shall be played by Stroke Play over 18 holes.
- (b) The Winner will be the competitor who returns the lowest gross score over 18 holes. In the event of a tie for first place after 18 holes, the Winner will be decided by a sudden death play-off over holes as specified by the Championship Committee.
- (c) Other ties will be decided on the score for the last 9, 6, 3, 2, 1 holes.
- (d) Players shall walk at all times during a stipulated round, unless otherwise agreed in advance by the County Secretary.
- (e) Subsidiary Competitions by age groups shall be played within the Championship. The Championship Winner, the Runner-up, and the players winning 3<sup>rd</sup> place and Best Nett overall shall not be eligible for subsidiary group prizes.

#### 3. Prizes:

- (a) No competitor may receive more than one prize.
- (b) The Overall Winner will hold the George Stubbings Salver for one year and will receive a Silver medal and a Voucher.
- (c) The Overall Runner-up will receive a Bronze medal and a Voucher.
- (d) Overall 3<sup>rd</sup> Place will receive a Voucher.
- (e) The player aged between 55 and 59 years with the Best Gross Score will hold the relevant new trophy for one year and receive a Voucher.
- (f) The player aged between 60 and 64 years with the Best Gross Score will hold the relevant new trophy for one year and receive a Voucher.
- (g) The player aged between 65 and 69 years with the Best Gross score will hold the Carl Bretherton Salver for one year and receive a Voucher.
- (h) The player aged 70 years or over with the Best Gross Score will hold the Cyril Jewsbury Shield for one year and receive a Voucher.
- (i) The player with the Best Net score overall will hold the Bill Dudley-Evans Salver for one year and receive a Voucher.
- (j) Vouchers will also be awarded for the Best Net scores in each of the following age categories:  
55 - 59, 60 - 64, 65 - 69, 70 and Over.
- (k) Prize Winners and all other competitors are expected to be present at the prizegiving.

#### 4. Entry Applications:

Applications must only be made on the Entry Form, all cheques should be made payable to The Warwickshire Union of Golf Clubs Limited (or WUGC Ltd.) and must be sent with your completed Entry Application Form, together with a 1st class S.A.E. to :

- 5. It is required that ties and jackets be worn in the Club House after play.
- 6. The Competition will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club, and as supplemented by Local Rules.
- 7. Any questions arising as to qualifications, Rules of Golf or any other points will be considered by the Championship Committee whose decision will be final. The Committee reserve the right to limit the number of entries.
