

## WARWICKSHIRE MENS SENIORS CHAMPIONSHIP 2010

The 32<sup>nd</sup> Warwickshire Mens Seniors Championship will be played on Monday 21<sup>st</sup> June 2010 at Shirley Golf Club, Stratford Road, Monkspath, Shirley, Solihull, West Midlands B90 4EW

**Closing date for Entry Applications is Friday 4<sup>th</sup> June 2010**

### **2010 CONDITIONS OF ENTRY AND PLAY**

1. **Entry Qualifications:**

To be eligible to enter, a player must :

- (a) have reached the age of 55 years before the day of the competition.
- (b) be in possession of an ACTIVE CONGU playing handicap at the date of entry as follows:

Aged 55 to 59:	Maximum 12 handicap
Aged 60 to 64 :	Maximum 13 handicap
Aged 65 to 69 :	Maximum 14 handicap
Aged 70 and over :	Maximum 16 handicap

- (c) enter this competition on the basis of their CONGU handicap
- (d) be a playing Member of a Warwickshire Golf Club affiliated to the County Golf Union.
- (e) obtain the permission of the County Secretary if he has represented another County, or played in another County's Championships during the preceding 12 months

2. **Conditions of Play:**

- (a) The Championship shall be played by Stroke Play over 18 holes.
- (b) The Winner will be the competitor who returns the lowest gross score over 18 holes.
- (c) In the event of a tie for first place after the specified number of holes, the Championship shall be decided on the day by a sudden death playoff over holes as specified by the Championship Committee.
- (d) Other ties will be decided on a count back basis taking into account, in sequence, the Gross scores on the last 9, 6, 3, 2 and 1 holes, until a result is obtained. If this does not produce a result the scores on earlier holes will be taken into account on a similar basis until a result is obtained.
- (e) The use of ride-on buggies is generally prohibited in Warwickshire Union of Golf Club events. Players should walk at all times unless permission to ride has been given by the Championship Committee. Permission will only be given in exceptional circumstances.
- (f) The use of Distance Measuring Devices which conform with the current Rules of Golf is allowed.
- (g) Players driver heads and golf balls must conform with the current Rules of Golf.
- (h) Mobile telephones are not permitted to be used on the course, except in case of emergencies.

3. **Prizes:**

- (a) Subsidiary Competitions by age groups shall be played within the Championship. The Championship Winner, the Runner-up, and the players winning 3<sup>rd</sup> place and Best Nett overall shall not be eligible for subsidiary group prizes.
- (b) No competitor may receive more than one prize.
- (c) The Overall Winner will hold the George Stubbings Salver for one year and will receive a Silver medal and a Voucher.
- (d) The Overall Runner-up will receive a Bronze medal and a Voucher.
- (e) Overall 3<sup>rd</sup> Place will receive a Voucher.
- (f) The player aged 55 to 59 years with the Best Gross Score will hold the Directors Cup for one year and receive a Voucher.
- (g) The player aged 60 to 64 years with the Best Gross Score will hold the Jim Dean Cup for one year and receive a Voucher.
- (h) The player aged 65 to 69 years with the Best Gross score will hold the Carl Bretherton Salver for one year and receive a Voucher.
- (i) The player aged 70 years or over with the Best Gross Score will hold the Cyril Jewsbury Shield for one year and receive a Voucher.
- (j) The player with the Best Net score overall will hold the Bill Dudley-Evans Salver for one year and receive a Voucher.
- (k) Vouchers will also be awarded for the Best Net scores in each of the following age categories:  
55 to 59, 60 to 64, 65 to 69, 70 and Over.
- (l) Prize Winners and all other competitors are expected to be present at the prizegiving.

4. **Entry Applications:**

- (a) Applications and Payments may be made on-line via the County website – [www.warksgolf.co.uk](http://www.warksgolf.co.uk) - OR by post.
- (b) Postal entries will only be accepted on the official WUGC Entry Form available on the County website or from your Club Secretary/Manager.
- (c) Entry Applications – both postal and on-line - and related Fees, must be received by the WUGC County Secretary NOT LATER THAN the specified closing date for entries.
- (d) No Entry Fees will be refunded unless intimation of scratching is received PRIOR TO the Draw Sheet being issued.

5. It is required that ties and jackets be worn in the Club House after play.

6. The Competition will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club, and as supplemented by Local Rules.

7. Any questions arising as to Entry Qualifications, Rules of Golf, Resolution of Exceptional Ties or any other points will be considered by the Championship Committee whose decision will be final. The Committee reserve the right to limit the number of entries.
