

WARWICKSHIRE LADIES COUNTY GOLF ASSOCIATION LIMITED

INTER-CLUB TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP

QUALIFICATIONS

The Warwickshire Inter-Club Team Championship shall be open to teams of female golfers who are members of clubs affiliated to Warwickshire Ladies' County Golf Association Limited, have amateur status in accordance with the current Amateur Status Rules of R&A Rules Limited, and who hold an Active CONGU handicap.

Format: Aggregate of 18 holes stroke play by each team member.
Handicap Limit: 26

REGULATIONS

- (a) Entries must be submitted on the official entry form by the Ladies' Hon. Secretaries to the Hon. Competition Secretary of WLCGA Ltd not later than the specified date, and must be accompanied by the entry fee.
- (b) Starting times shall be advised to clubs.
- (c) Team members must register in person at the Competition Desk at least 15 minutes before they are due on the tee. Telephone calls may be accepted in exceptional circumstances.
- (d) Current CONGU handicap certificates must be produced before play. A competitor unable to produce such certificate shall be disqualified, which will result in the disqualification of the team.
- (e) Each team member's scorecard must be returned promptly after her round is completed.
- (f) In the event of a tie for a trophy, the trophy will be held for an equal period of time by each of the teams, which have tied, and the voucher values shared equally.
- (g) The decision of the Competitions and Championship Committee ('the Committee') shall, in all matters, be final.

CONDITIONS

- (a) The Championship shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by R&A Rules Limited and Local Rules approved by the Committee.
- (b) Each participating club shall nominate a team of five players and two reserves. Should one or more of the nominated team members be unable to compete, the club may only substitute a nominated reserve up to the advised registration time of the affected player or players. Any other changes to the team will not be allowed unless sanctioned in exceptional circumstances by the County Captain or nominated official in her absence.
- (c) A draw will be made between clubs.
- (d) One round of 18 holes shall be played by each team member.

- (e) Distance Measuring Devices are not permitted
- (f) Competitors may not engage a professional or assistant professional golfer as a caddie. (See Rules of Golf, Appendix 1, Part C - Conditions of Competition).
- (g) Each team member shall start at her advertised time of starting (Rule 6-3a). If the competitor arrives at her starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after her starting time, in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7, the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes at the first hole. The penalty for lateness beyond five minutes is Disqualification (Note to Rule 6-3a).
- (h) A team is disqualified if any team member is disqualified
- (i) Transportation Policy (Buggies).
A player suffering from a physical or mental impairment that has a sustained or long term effect may request the use of a buggy by supplying a valid current medical certificate to the Committee in accordance with the WLCGA Ltd Transportation Policy.
NB: If restrictions regarding the use of buggies are in force at the host club, these must be adhered to.

TROPHIES

The Daisy Harthill Cup shall be awarded to the team returning the lowest aggregate net scores and shall be held for one year. Members of the winning team shall receive a voucher.

The Chipman Cup shall be awarded to the team returning the lowest aggregate gross score and shall be held for one year. Members of the winning team shall receive a voucher.

In the event of a tie for the trophies, the trophies will be held for an equal period by each of the teams tied and the voucher values shared equally. In the event of a team returning the lowest aggregate gross score and the lowest aggregate net score they shall hold both trophies for one year and the members shall receive the aggregate gross voucher. The members of the team returning the second lowest aggregate net score shall receive aggregate net vouchers.
