

WARWICKSHIRE LADIES COUNTY GOLF ASSOCIATION

INTER-CLUB TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP

QUALIFICATIONS

The Warwickshire Inter-Club Team Championship shall be open to teams of female golfers from clubs affiliated to Warwickshire Ladies' County Golf Association as well as Associate Members of the Warwickshire Ladies' County Golf Association who may also be a full member of another County Association. All team members must be members of the club they represent, have amateur status in accordance with the current Amateur Status Rules of the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews and hold a Active CONGU handicap.

REGULATIONS

- (a) Entries must be sent by the Ladies' Hon. Competition Secretary of the Association not later than the specified date.
- (b) The entry fee of £80 must accompany the completed entry form.
- (c) Starting times shall be advised to clubs
- (d) Team members should register at the Competition Desk at least 15 minutes before they are due on the tee. Telephone calls may be accepted in EXCEPTIONAL CIRCUMSTANCES..
- (e) Handicap certificates must be produced before play. A competitor unable to produce an up-to-date certificate shall be disqualified, which will result in the disqualification of the team
- (f) Team members may not engage a professional or assistant professional golfer as a caddie.
- (g) A team member not on the tee at her advertised time of starting renders herself liable to disqualification under Rule 6-3a. In the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification under Rule 33-7, if the competitor arrives at her starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after her starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes at the first hole. Penalty for lateness beyond five minutes is disqualification. Disqualification of a team member results in disqualification of the team.
- (h) The decision of the WLCGA Committee shall, in all matters, be final.
- (i) In the event of a tie for a trophy, the trophy will be held for an equal period of time by each of the teams, which has tied, and the voucher values shared equally.
- (j) All team players' scorecards must be returned promptly after the round is completed.

CONDITIONS

- (a) The Championship shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and Local Rules approved by the Committee.
- (b) Each participating club shall nominate a team of five players and two reserves. Should one or more of the nominated team members be unable to compete, the club may only substitute a nominated reserve up to the advised registration time of the affected player or players. Any other changes to the team will not be allowed unless sanctioned in exceptional circumstances by the County Captain or nominated official in her absence.
- (c) One round of 18 holes shall be played by each team member. A draw will be made.
- (d) The handicap limit for this event is 26

TROPHIES

The Daisy Harthill Cup shall be awarded to the team returning the lowest aggregate nett scores and shall be held for one year. Members of the winning team shall receive a voucher.

The Chipman Cup shall be awarded to the team returning the lowest aggregate gross scores and shall be held for one year. Members of the winning team shall receive a voucher.

In the event of a tie for the trophies, the trophies will be held for an equal period by each of the teams tied and the voucher values shared equally. In the event of a team returning the lowest aggregate gross score and the lowest aggregate nett score they shall hold both trophies for one year and the members shall receive the aggregate gross voucher. The members of the team returning the second lowest aggregate nett score shall receive aggregate nett vouchers.
