

WARWICKSHIRE BOYS UNDER 14's CHAMPIONSHIP 2006

The inaugural Warwickshire Boys Under 14's Championship will be played on Tuesday 8th August 2006 at North Warwickshire Golf Club, Hampton Lane, Meriden, West Midlands CV7 7LL

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Qualifications:

To be eligible to enter, a player must :-

- (a) be under the age of 14 years at 00:00 hours on 1st January 2006
- (b) be in possession of a playing handicap not exceeding 36
- (c) have been born in Warwickshire or be a Junior Member of a Warwickshire Golf Club affiliated to the County Golf Union or be the son of a Full Member of an affiliated Warwickshire Golf Club - provided that they have not represented, or played in another County's Junior or Boys Championship, since 9th August 2005.

2. Conditions of Play:

- (a) The Championship shall be played by Stroke Play over 27 holes.
- (b) The Winner will be the competitor who returns the lowest gross score over 27 holes. In the event of a tie after 27 holes, the Winner, and all other ties, will be decided on the score for the second round on the last 9, 6, 3, 2, 1 holes.
- (c) No caddies will be allowed, and players shall walk at all times during a stipulated round.

3. Prizes:

- (a) The Winner will hold a Salver for one year, and will receive a Silver medal and Voucher.
- (b) The Runner-up will receive a Bronze medal and Voucher.
- (c) There will also be Vouchers for 3rd Best Gross score, and 1st, 2nd and 3rd Best Net scores, over 27 holes.
- (d) A Voucher will also be awarded for the Best Gross score over 27 holes by a competitor under the age of 12 years at 00:00 hours on 1st January 2006.
- (e) There will be a Voucher awarded to the Winner of the Putting Competition being run on the day.
- (f) No competitor may receive more than one prize.
- (g) Prize Winners and all other competitors are expected to be present at the prizegiving.

4. Entry Applications:

- (a) It is a strict condition of entry that where a competitor will be under the age of 18 years on the date of the competition, a Parental Consent Form is completed and returned with the Entry Form.
- (b) Applications must only be made on the Entry Form, all cheques should be made payable to Warwickshire Union of Golf Clubs (or WUGC) and must be sent with your completed Entry Application Form and a Parental Consent Form, together with a 1st class S.A.E. to :

5. It is required that ties and jackets be worn in the Club House after play.
6. The Competition will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club, and as supplemented by the Local Rules of North Warwickshire Golf Club.
7. Any questions arising as to qualifications, Rules of Golf or any other points will be considered by the Executive Committee of the WUGC whose decision will be final. The Committee reserve the right to limit the number of entries.
