All competitors should collect their cards from the Warwickshire Union Secretary, Graham Hayes, at the Registration Desk located in the Clubhouse, prior to play. Players are required to report to the Starter at the 1st Tee at least 5 minutes before their allotted Start Time.

Play will be from White Tees, and the morning round will be a 'Qualifying Competition' for handicap purposes.

The Prize Presentation is expected to take place at approximately 6.30 p.m. It is also expected that all competitors will stay for the prize-giving. If a prizewinner is unable to attend the prize-giving then he should inform the Secretary in advance and arrange a deputy to collect his prize.

Competitors should note that 'smart dress' (jackets and ties) is required in the clubhouse after play.
