

THE WARWICKSHIRE CUP 2008-2009

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Club knock-out foursomes.
2. Scratch matchplay.
3. Only one team per club.
4. Teams to comprise 3 pairs. The names and pairings selected for each match may be changed for any subsequent matches. However, no one player can have represented any other club in this competition during the same winter period.
5. Only single-figure players eligible.
6. Matches must be played consecutively.
7. It is the responsibility of the first-named club in the draw to arrange the match.
8. It is recommended that matches should be played at weekends or during holidays, and either early morning or after 10.00 am.
9. The home club to provide the course as they see fit, i.e. front or back tees and normal or temporary greens.
10. Home club should reserve the tee times.
11. If it is known in advance that the home course is unplayable then the venue must be switched to the away team.
12. It is the responsibility of both captains to liaise a reasonable time prior to each match to assess the state of the home course and the possibility of play.
13. If any match is halved, then this will only go down the 19th if the overall result of the match is inconclusive.
14. If all matches are halved, then the 1st match on the team sheet will go down the 19th.
15. Teams and pairings to be declared 15 minutes before the tee-off time, and all team members must be present.
16. In the event of an incomplete pairing, then that match shall be forfeited and the other team will be allowed to change their order.
17. No meals will normally be provided.
18. Preliminary round if necessary to reduce to 32 teams in 1st round proper.
19. The final (18 holes) shall be played at The Warwickshire early in April 2009. Date to be specified on draw sheet.
20. The results of each match should be communicated to the County Secretary, G.G. Hayes (024 76 422793) without delay.
